You MUST call or text one of the above if you are:

- Exiting the event
- Pausing your race for more than 30 minutes

Failure to do so will result in possible disqualification or a ban from future events.

- Call or text, or report to checkpoint/safety boat volunteers any time you see:

 Obvious violations of the SDKC rules, such as littering or abusive behavior
 - Another racer who seems to be in dire straits
 - Hazards to navigation in the water or on shore
 - Unpleasant behavior by spectators, boaters or others
