HIGHWAY

Lee Goergen, Highway Superintendent/Weed Supervisor, presented an agreement with the State of South Dakota to provide for the striping and continuing maintenance of county roads within Sanborn County. Motion by Blindauer, seconded by Ohlrogge, to enter into this agreement with the state. All ayes. Motion carried. Goergen presented an approach request for Rob Maher on the south side of 236th St in the NE/4 28-106-62. Motion by Ohlrogge, seconded by S. Larson, to approve the request. All ayes. Motion carried. Goergen also presented a resolution to amend the 5 Year Plan for Bridge Improvement Grant Program. Motion by P. Larson, seconded by Blindauer, to adopt the following resolutions. All ayes.
