

**COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
MAY 1, 2018**

Sanborn County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, May 1, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Ebersdorfer presiding. Other members present were: Ohlrogge, Blindauer, S. Larson, and P. Larson. Also present was Auditor Larson. Motion by Ohlrogge, seconded by S. Larson, to approve the minutes as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

HIGHWAY

Lee Goergen, Highway Superintendent/Weed Supervisor, met with the board. Motion by P. Larson, seconded by Blindauer, to enter into an agreement with the Department of Transportation to provide for the striping and continuing maintenance of county roads within Sanborn County. All ayes. Motion carried. Motion by Ohlrogge, seconded by S. Larson, to purchase off the State bid from Highway Improvement for crack sealing. All ayes. Motion carried. Road limits will be removed today.
