

**COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS
MAY 5, 2020**

Sanborn County Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Ebersdorfer presiding. Present was P. Larson, S. Larson, Ohlrogge, and Blindauer. Auditor Larson was also present. Motion by S. Larson, seconded by Ohlrogge, to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried.

HIGHWAY

Stacy Mendenhall, Highway Foreman and Sheri Kogel, Administrative Assistant met with the board. Kogel presented an Agreement with the State for Striping Roads for 10.5 miles. Motion by P. Larson, seconded by Blindauer to agree to the striping. All ayes. Motion carried.

MALT BEVERAGE RENEWAL

Hearing no objections, motion by P. Larson, seconded by S. Larson, to renew the malt liquor licenses for Alt Investments- Country Pumper and John Doren – Doren’s Bar. All ayes. Motion carried.

COMBINING PRECINCTS

Auditor Larson presented a resolution to allow combining precincts and having one location for voting for the primary election. The Covid 19 has made obtaining election workers very difficult. Also the state has launched a campaign to encourage absentee voting which should lessen the number of people at the voting precinct. Motion by Blindauer, seconded by Ohlrogge, to pass the following resolution:

RESOLUTION 20-6

WHEREAS, SDCL 12-14-1 requires the board of county commissioners to provide for election precincts throughout its county and shall designate polling places within such precincts, and

WHEREAS, commissioners wish to limit the exposure to COVID 19 by utilizing one polling place,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sanborn County Board of Commissioners sets the polling places for the following precincts:

POLLING PLACE: Woonsocket Community Center (102 S Dumont Ave.)

Precinct 1 (Afton, Floyd, Benedict, Oneida, Artesian City, Diana, Ravenna);

Precinct 2 (Butler, Letcher, Letcher City, Logan, Elliott);

Precinct 4 (Jackson, Twin Lake, Woonsocket Township, Silver Creek, Ward 2)

Precinct 5 (Ward 1 and Ward 3 in Woonsocket City and Warren Township)

DRUG TASK FORCE

Auditor Larson presented the joint powers agreement with the James Valley Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force. The purpose of this is to create a force to combine and coordinate law enforcement investigative services with the counties of Aurora, Davison, Hanson, Sanborn, and the City of Mitchell. This agreement will begin on April 1st of 2020 and continue for one year. Motion by P. Larson, seconded by S. Larson, to enter into the agreement. All ayes. Motion carried.

DRAINAGE PERMIT

On behalf of the Drainage Board, motion by Blindauer, seconded by S. Larson, to grant The Woonsocket School Permit #009-2020 for Drainage for the existing track and football field location on the north side of Highway 34, just west of N. 1st Ave. All ayes. Motion carried.

COURTHOUSE DOORS LOCKED

The board agreed to keep the courthouse doors locked for another two weeks. They will reevaluate at that time.
